Priority country: Political prioritization & Multi-stakeholder approaches

Honduras joined SWA in 2017. Honduras aims to achieve, within the vision statements of their National Plan (2010-2022) to: reduce by half the percentage of people without sustainable access to drinking water by 2022 and to reduce to less than 10% the percentage of people without sustainable access to drinking water by 2034.
